OUR HOME

Burnt Tree Croft is built on two floors with each of the bedroom corridors having well equipped bathroom facilities and their own dining and sitting areas, providing the opportunity to eat, meet and socialise in smaller groups. There are also small residents' kitchens, just right for making a cup of tea or a light snack.

A large central 'function' room, where bingo is ever-popular, acts very much as focal point for residents and makes for a sociable home, whilst a number



of 'quiet' rooms are ideal for reading the newspaper in peace.

With forty residential bedrooms and a day care centre our home is also a community where people meet new friends and enjoy each day to the full.

We are also able to offer specialist dementia care and a supportive environment for Functionally Mentally Ill people.

The garden is pretty, with a number of lovely trees whilst a flat patio and decking area at the front of the building looks onto the park; here residents enjoy the fresh air and watching the world go by.

A FULFILLING LIFESTYLE

Each day at Burnt Tree Croft can be as busy - or as peaceful - as you wish.

We have various activities most days which include favourites such as bingo, arts and crafts, and gentle exercise. A Church service is provided by St Stephens Church every month and we have a monthly social evening. Our specially adapted vehicles offer easy access for wheelchairs so weekly trips out to, for example, the countryside, are possible for most residents. Each year we also go further afield; a trip to the seaside for fish and chips is very popular.

We actively encourage residents to maintain the family, friends and community links they had prior to living at Burnt Tree Croft, but whatever the degree of independence possible for each resident we work hard to make everyday as enjoyable and rewarding as possible.

All our care staff have appropriate training and qualifications supported by the Sheffcare commitment to continuous



improvement and in house training, ensuring that we meet - and exceed - the latest standards of care. We also able to provide specialist dementia care.

Our own chefs take great pride in the food, freshly cooked each day in our kitchens. The traditional pies and roast dinners are mouthwatering but egg, chips and beans is a great favourite too. We often ask our residents for their input regarding the menu and this is reflected in regular changes and new choices. We are happy to cater for friends or family members joining us for a meal or a snack too.

Our dedicated activity team ensures that everyone has the opportunity to continue with favourite hobbies or explore new activities.

With it's warm, cosy decor, comfortable sitting rooms, dining areas with attractive place settings, television lounges and the large function room, Burnt Tree Croft is a comfortable, sociable 'home from home'.
