OUR HOME

Deerlands is a bungalow-style building with each of the bedroom corridors connecting to a large central 'function' room which acts very much as focal point for residents. This makes for a sociable home, easy to get around and quick to find company or help when needed.

With forty residential bedrooms plus twelve day care places our home is also a community where people meet new friends and enjoy each day to the full. We are also able to offer specialist dementia care.



Built on a single floor the bedrooms at Deerlands are light and airy, sharing facilities such as well equipped bathrooms, dining rooms and sitting rooms on each corridor, providing the opportunity to eat, meet and socialise in smaller groups.

There's a spacious sitting room which is well used for group activities such as ever-popular bingo, plus the larger communal area where everyone gets together for entertainment, activities or just a chat.

The garden is pretty and seen very much as an extension to the function room, which looks out onto it. Raised beds, colourful mature planting and screened areas create our own little haven of peace and tranquillity.

Each day at Deerlands can be as busy - or as peaceful - as you wish. We have various activities five days per week which include favourites such as bingo, arts and crafts, and gentle exercise.

Our specially adapted vehicles offer easy access for wheelchairs so trips out to, for example, the Yorkshire Wildlife Park and Cleethorpes are possible for most residents. Our annual barge trip is a very popular tradition and regular social events to which relatives are invited are eagerly anticipated.

We actively encourage residents to maintain the family, friends and community links they had prior to living at Deerlands, but whatever the degree of independence possible for each resident we work hard to make every day as enjoyable and rewarding as possible.
