Our specially adapted vehicles offer easy access for wheelchairs so trips out to, for example, nearby Wentworth Garden Centre for a delicious icecream are possible for most residents.

We actively encourage residents to maintain the family, friends and community links they had prior to living at Midhurst Road, but whatever the degree of independence possible for each resident we work hard to make everyday as enjoyable and rewarding as possible.
