Springwood is arranged over three floors, with forty bedrooms for residential clients and ten day care places. We benefit from many windows throughout the building, letting in lots of natural light and making for a bright environment.

Each of the bedroom corridors has well equipped bathrooms and their own attractive dining rooms and cosy sitting rooms, providing the opportunity to eat, meet and socialise in smaller groups. There are also smaller family kitchens where residents,



a friend or relative can make a drink or a light snack.

We have a large central function room where everyone gets together to enjoy group activities and entertainment, quiet rooms ideal for a peaceful read, whilst our music rooms also provide the venue for daily life skills and activities in smaller groups. This all makes for a sociable, simulating home, with company or help when needed and just as easy to enjoy privacy and a quiet time.

Springwood is a small, happy community where people meet new friends and enjoy each day to the full - and where we work hard to create a 'family home' lifestyle where residents can continue to be involved in many household activities.
